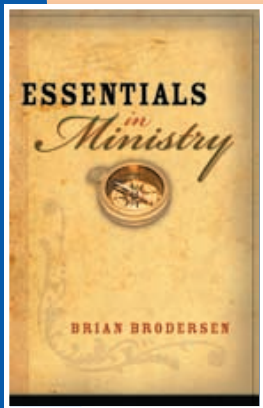


Love: The More Excellent Way

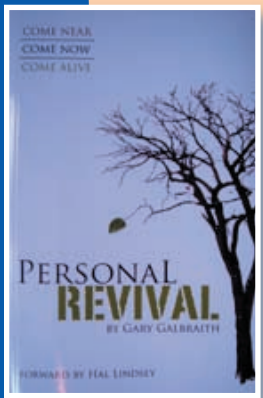
