CD by Mary Barrett


Mary Barrett, long-time worship leader and Calvary Chapel musician, was diagnosed with a rare, aggressive cancer and went home to be with the Lord on November 10, 2008. She chose to use the final weeks of her life to leave a legacy—a collection of songs on a farewell album entitled *The Vanishing Point*. Pondering the deep things of God with a simple heart of faith, Mary pores over the Father's love letter, the Bible, and distills the resulting comfort into songs like "I Will Care for You" and "Here to Stay." Chapter 3 of the Book of Habakkuk inspired "I Will Rejoice," which was recorded just two weeks

before Mary's death. The victory in her voice is unmistakable. In fact, it echoes across all 16 original songs. As a worship leader, Mary met the first requirement—she was a worshipper herself.

In *The Vanishing Point*, we have one more opportunity to follow her lead.


Philippians Bible Study


Never Surrender


The NKJV Explorer's Study Bible for Kids
